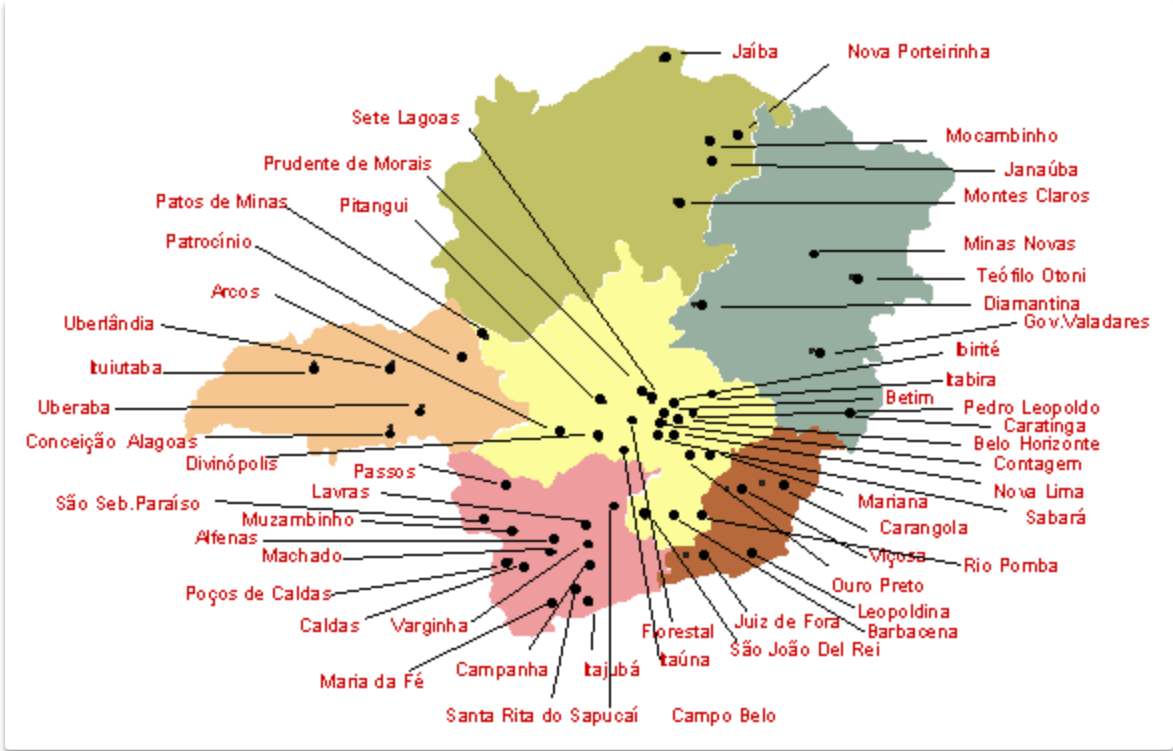

INVESTMENTS

About US\$ 100 million applied in:

- 5.000 research projects per year
- 7.200 scholarships
- Support for 1.400 events every year
- Innovation initiatives

Funding mechanisms

- Bottom-up projects – all areas of knowledge
- Top-down projects – strategic areas for the State:
 - Important areas in which there is need (capacity building, induced research)
 - Opportunities (areas in which we have established competence and may play a leading role)
- Collaborative research –
 - Regional and national collaboration
 - International collaboration (bilateral and with CONFAP)



INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

➤ Current Partners - 34 Institutions in 13 countries:

Australia, Canada, France, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Mozambique, Netherlands, Russia, United Kingdom, United States, South Korea and Sweden.
